

**Conditions for entry to the territory of the Czech Republic and quarantine measures (from April 27<sup>th</sup> 2020, 0:00, for the duration of the state of emergency)**

- All persons entering the territory of the Czech Republic are subject to all other valid emergency and crisis measures adopted by the Government of the Czech Republic in connection with the COVID-19 epidemic.

**Citizens of Switzerland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Iceland and the United Kingdom are regarded as EU citizens.**

**The testing results certificate** means a document issued by a physician or a public health protection organ confirming that a RT-PCR test on SARS-CoV-2 was done with a negative result not longer than 4 days ago; the test is done on own expenses. The testing results certificate is confirmed on a template document, which is available at the MoI website.

**The ordered mandatory quarantine** means quarantine in accordance with § 64 letter a) in conjunction with paragraph 7 letter a) of Act No. 258/2000 Coll., on the protection of public health and on the amendment of some related acts, as amended, for a period of 14 days.
